1. HELLIAN HELLES LAGER

5.4% ABV 23 IBU .5L \$5.00
 Growler \$15 Sample \$1.75
 A sessionable, malt forward Munich-Style Lager with a touch of spicy German Spalt hops for aroma and flavor and just enough bitterness in the finish to balance out the malt sweetness. Formulated by SAAZ home brewer Larry Reuter, who won Best of Show at the 2016 Son of Brewzilla competition. This beer will be entered in the GABF as a Pro-Am entry in October. **Gold Medal and Best of Show 2017 Cleveland Oktoberfest.**



2. SPOOKY TOOTH IMPERIAL PUMPKIN ALE

9.0% ABV 22 IBU \$6.25 12oz Snifter
 Growler TO GO \$23 Sample \$2.50
 Rich amber color with aroma of sweet pumpkin pie and savory spices with hints of sweet malt. Rich and creamy with a chewy mouthfeel that you can sink your teeth into. Flavors of pumpkin up front then sweet malt, pie crust, spice, hints of brown sugar and a clean finish. We stopped just short of the whipped cream. But we like the way you think.



3. HEAD HUNTER IPA

7.5% ABV 87 IBU 16 oz Pint \$5.75

 Uncivilized and aggressive this west coast styled IPA packs wicked hop flavors and aroma. Savage amounts of Simcoe, Columbus and Centennial hops define this brews signature pine and citrus notes. 5. HOP STALKER FRESH HOP IPA

7.0%abv 80 ibu 16oz \$6.25
 Growler TO GO \$19 Sample \$2.00
 Deep in the Yakima Valley, our hop obsessed Brewmaster went commando in search of his prized nuggets. His mission: capture the freshest hop flowers he could sneak up on. In this case, Simcoe. Then he wet-hopped this bad ass brew for a deliciously dank IPA. Out of the wild emerged The Hop Stalker.



6. MIDNIGHT MOONLIGHT BLACK IPA 7.8% ABV 79 IBU

 Sample \$2.00 Dank resinous & citrusy hops flex their muscles while an aggressive, palate scraping bitterness rips through the mouth. 7. BOOGALOO BELGIAN BLONDE ALE

7.2%abv 25 ibu .4l goblet \$5.50/ Growler TO GO \$17/Sample \$1.75
 A true Belgian style blonde ale, light copper in color with spicy herbal undertones. This beer will dance with your senses and get your blood pumping.



8. VIENNA LAGER

INDIA PALE ALE (IPA)/ PALE ALE

IPAs are basically stronger, hoppier pale ales. Over the years, the style has evolved and even spawned a few subspecies or three.

Troeg's, Hop Knife — Hershey, PA 16oz Pint \$ 5.50

Wet Hopped Harvest Ale 6.2%ABV 87 IBU

Hop Knife Harvest Ale recognizes the time honored tradition of hand-harvesting hops at the peak of maturity. At the end of fermentation, the beer flows through our HopCyclone releasing a bounty of preserved citrus rind, crushed jungle and tropical aromas.

Boulder, Mojo IPA NITRO — Boulder, CO 16oz Pint \$ 5.75

Nitro IPA 7.2%ABV 70 IBU

Mojo India Pale Ale was inspired by the English who first shipped their ales to India and the Far East - but brewed with an attitude of the great American West. Pale in color but packed with flavor, Mojo reflects the perfect balance of hop bitterness and malt character. The unique Amarillo hop creates a big, grapefruit-like citrus flavor and aroma, making Mojo a very zesty IPA that's crisp and refreshing.

Platform, Speed Merchant — Cleveland, OH 16oz pint \$5.50

White IPA 6.6% ABV

A sharp bite from the wheat malt is followed by American hop flavors

Mad Tree, PsychOPathy — Cincinnati, OH 16oz. Pint \$5.50

India Pale Ale 6.9%ABV

The subtle malt backbone combats the bitterness and intensity of floral, grassy, and citrus hop flavors. However, taste is perception. What's your slant?

Rochester Mills, When Worlds Collide — Rochester MI

Wheat IPA 6.0% ABV 60 IBU \$5.50 Pint

American wheat IPA that combines the hoppy goodness of an American IPA with the crisp, bread-like, "zing" from an American-style wheat beer into one very tasty unfiltered beer that's out of this world! Featuring Chinook, Centennial and Cascade hops from near by Top Hop Farms and all American flaked & malted wheat. Enjoy the haze.

BrewDog, Elvis Juice — Ellon, Scotland 16oz. Pint \$5.75

India Pale Ale w/ Grapefruit 6.5%ABV 40 IBU

An American IPA with a bitter edge that will push your citrus tolerance to the brink and back; Elvis Juice is loaded with tart pithy grapefruit peel. This IPA has a caramel malt base, supporting a full frontal citrus overload - grapefruit peel piled on top of intense us aroma hops.

Waves of crashing pine, orange and grapefruit round out this citrus infused IPA.

BOTTLED BEER



Orval, Trappist Ale Florenville, Belgium

Belgian Golden Ale

6.2%ABV 11.2 oz. Bottle \$8.00

In contrast to all the others, the Orval Trappist brewery makes only one beer for the general public. It has an intensely aromatic and dry character. Between the first and second fermentations there is also an additional dry-hopping process. Through this the beer acquires its pronounced hoppy aroma and extra dry taste.

STOUTS, PORTERS & BROWN ALES

Dark brews with a roasted or toasted taste. Stouts are usually stronger & darker than porters. Nowadays though anything goes!

Deschutes, Black Butte Porter — Bend, OR 16oz. Pint \$5.75

Porter 5.2%ABV 30IBU

With a dark beer as our first and flagship brand, Black Butte defined Deschutes as a radical player. A slight hop bitterness up front enhances the distinctive chocolate and roasted finish. It's prized for its creamy mouthfeel and intense complex flavors

BrewDog, Jet Black Heart — Ellon, Scotland 16oz. Pint \$5.75

Oatmeal Milk Stout w/ Vanilla 4.7%ABV 30 IBU

This sable stout is black as pitch and smooth as hell. Jet Black Heart is a milk stout; roasty malt flavours of coffee and chocolate, bound to a decadent full-bodied richness. Flaked oats and wheat add to the velvet mouth-feel, with the carbonation adding a honeycomb texture. Magnum and Sorachi Ace bring a berry & citrus fruitiness that amplifies the chocolate character of this inky leviathan.

LAGER BEER

Broad family of beers with a wide range of strengths, colors and bitterness. Lagers are fermented with a different strain of yeast than ales, ferment at cooler temperatures and usually have a longer, colder maturation period (a.k.a. lagering). Lager is the German verb for "to store".

Victory, Festbier — Downington, PA .5L \$5.25

Oktoberfest 5.6% ABV

This Oktoberfest beer is full-bodied, yet infinitely smooth.

Seductively malty, with a kiss of the hops for balance. This is our Festbier. Painstakingly crafted from German malts, decoction brewed for full flavor and carefully aged for depth of character

Sibling Revelry, Oak'd — Westlake, OH .5L \$5.75

Oktoberfest fermented w/ Oak 5.7%ABV 25 IBU

This classic German style festbier has a light malt aroma and medium body with subtle sweet notes of toasted vanilla and oak. We proudly brewed with ingredients sourced from Cleveland's own Haus Malts to craft this flavorful fall favorite

BELGIAN STYLE ALES

Remarkable and varied styles. A colorful, individualistic assortment of beer. Usually very complex, exotic and spicy.

Abtsolution, Dark Belgian Ale — Belgium

9% ABV 12oz snifter \$9.00

Brewed & bottled at De Proefbrouwerij in Belgium, this collaboration between Belgian brewer Dirk Naudts of De Proefbrouwerij & Daniel Carey of Wisconsin based New Glarus Brewing uses American ingredients Santiam & Chinook hops, which add pine & spice notes & lactose derived from local Wisconsin cows to impart extra mouth feel & sweetness. Aged in French & American oak which lends complexity & velvety smooth palate.

Working Class, Bank Boss — Cleveland, OH

Belgian Tripel 8.5% ABV 28 IBU 12oz Snifter \$5.50

A candy sweet and mildly spicy interpretation of the classic Belgian style. Be the Boss of this beer

MEAD: A GLUTEN FREE BEVERAGE

Hop Nectar Mead, Crafted Artisan Meadery 12% ABV

Mogadore, OH \$7.50 per glass \$24.99 750ml bottle

Hop Nectar is a semi-sweet metheglin mead that is crafted with 100% raw Ohio wildflower honey, water and yeast. This traditional mead is then dry hopped with Cascade Hops prior to bottling for a perfectly balanced profile. Ohio wildflower honey provides the perfect platform for showcasing the king of American hops.
