1. BENJAMIN DANKLIN IPA

5. KÖLSCH
5.1% ABV 25 IBU .4L \$4.75
Growler TO GO \$14.00 Sample \$1.50
A highly drinkable golden ale style that originated in the German city of Cologne and is still the beer of choice there. A crisp, well balanced beer with a delicate fruity aroma, soft maltiness, and subtle, noble hop aroma.



6. DANK SINATRA TRIPLE IPA
10.7% ABV 100+ IBU 12oz Snifter \$6.75

A cosmos of chocolate and cocoa flavors swirl in a glass. South American cocoa nibs Madagascar vanilla beans and milk sugar give this brew its decadent flavor, aroma and silky smooth finish. Warming yet well rounded with just the right amount of rich, dark malt and roast. Boldly go where no man has gone before!



8. MÄRZEN
5.6% ABV 22 IBU .5L \$5.25

Märzenbier is a full-bodied, extremely smooth Bavarian Style Lager with rich, malty flavors of bread and toast and a subdued bitterness but dry finish that encourages another drink. Usually brewed in March but we just couldn't wait. Closely related to both Oktoberfest and Vienna-style Lagers. (pronounced: Maert-zen).



9. SUNSHINE DAYDREAM SESSION IPA

4.9% ABV 60 IBU 16oz Pint \$5.75

As refreshing as wading in a cold stream in the morning sunshine or a walk among the tall trees, this beer has big hop aromas and flavors of citrus, peach, orange and tropical fruit with a nice light malt backbone. STOUTS, PORTERS & BROWN ALES

Dark brews with a roasted or toasted taste. Stouts are usually stronger & darker than porters. Nowadays though anything goes!

Founder's, Breakfast Stout — Grand Rapids, MI NITRO Coffee Oatmeal Stout 8.3%ABV 60IBU 12oz Snifter \$6.00
The coffee lover's consummate beer. Brewed with an abundance of flaked oats, bitter and imported chocolates, and Sumatra and Kona coffee, this stout has an intense fresh-roasted java nose topped with a frothy, cinnamon-colored head that goes forever.

Masthead Brewing, Tiramisu Underverse — Cleveland, OH Barrel Aged Imperial Stout 10.2%ABV 12oz Snifter \$7.00
A barrel aged stout worthy of dessert. Brewed with vanilla, cocoa and espresso beans for a decadent delight

UNIQUE AMERICAN STYLE ALES

Jackie O's, Razz Wheat — Athens, OH .4L \$4.75 Raspberry Wheat Ale 5%ABV
60% white wheat and 40% malted 2-row create a nice mild American wheat ale. After fermentation is complete, 84 pounds of fresh Oregon raspberries are added to the beer giving this ale a unique and playful personality. The rosy haze and sticky head embody a continuum of sour sweetness held together by a wheat backbone.

BELGIAN STYLE ALES

Remarkable and varied styles. A colorful, individualistic assortment of beer. Usually very complex, exotic and spicy.

Columbus Brewing Company, Saisoniere—Columbus, OH Saison / Farmhouse Ale 7.5% ABV .4L \$7.00
A Rustic yet refreshing Belgian-style saison.

SOUR BEER

Duchess De Bourgogne — Brouwerij Verheage, Belgium Flanders Red Ale 6.0%ABV .4L Goblet \$7.75
Belgian top fermented reddish brown ale, a blend of 8 to 18 months old beers following the careful maturation in oak barrels. The end result is a signature sourness unique to the style of Flanders Red Ale.

INDIA PALE ALE (IPA)/ PALE ALE

IPAs are basically stronger, hoppier pale ales. Over the years, the style has evolved and even spawned a few subspecies or three.

Great Divide, Hibernation — Denver, CO 12oz. Snifter \$5.50 English Style Old Ale 8.7% ABV
This robust, dry-hopped ale has a malty richness balanced with a complex hop profile and hearty, warming character.

Columbus Brewing, Bodhi — Columbus, OH 12oz. Snifter \$6.00 Double IPA 8.3%ABV 80 IBU
This double India pale ale is loaded with American hop character and is sure to awaken your senses and take you to a higher level of enlightenment.

Working Class, Patrolman's Pale Ale—Cleveland, OH American Pale Ale 6.1% ABV 50 IBU 16oz. Pint \$5.75
American-Style Pale Ale is so easy drinking or friends won't lose a beat on the street and response times of...well who knows. This ale is hopped with Warrior, Columbus & Centennial.

BARLEY WINE

Despite its name, a Barleywine (or Barley Wine) is very much a beer, albeit a very strong and often intense beer! A brew of this strength and complexity can be a challenge to the palate.

Fuller's, Golden Pride — Chiswick, England 12oz snifter \$5.50 English Barleywine 8.5%ABV
Golden Pride is full bodied, of moderate bitterness, moderately hopped and rich in malt. Full flavored, and reminiscent of sweet orange oil, toasted grains, and bread. Rich malty aromas lead to a similarly styled palate, with an intense finish. Sweet and bitter flavors are expressed in good balance in this weighty brew. ' Or as the late Michael Jackson, beer writer and connoisseur, put it: 'the Cognac of beers'.

MEAD : A GLUTEN FREE BEVERAGE

Wildflower Mead, Crafted Artisan Meadery 12% ABV Mogadore, OH \$6.50 per glass \$24 750ml bottle
Modern mead made for everyone. That's our purpose. Yet as we continue to push the boundaries with innovative meads, we've had one consistent request from our fans. You've asked for a back to the basics wildflower honey mead, something that showcases the textured honey character and nothing more. It's healthy to challenge the norm, but sometimes it's good to pause, reflect, and remember that sometimes simple is better. This is simply a traditional wildflower mead.

WHEAT BEER

Wheat beers are some of the most refreshing beers in the world. Made with a proportion of wheat malt in addition to malted barley. There are many styles and variations of wheat beers.

Saucy Brew Works, B.F. Hefe — Cleveland, OH .5L \$5.50 Hefeweizen 5.5%ABV 12 IBU

The best relationships are mutually beneficial with equal parts give and take. This Bavarian classic offers that kind of balance. It's not overly bitter or sweet. The original gangster of cloudy beers is thirst quenching and effervescent. The kind of BFF you can always count on for good times.

HARD CIDER: A GLUTEN FREE BEVERAGE

Ace, Hard Berry — Sebastopol, CA 16oz. Pint \$6.00 Berry Cider 5%ABV

This cider is a sweeter cider at 5% alcohol by volume. We ferment the apple juices for 14 days to dryness and then add back just enough fresh blackberry and raspberry juices to produce a light purple cider
