1. HELLIAN HELLES LAGER

5.4% ABV 23 IBU .5L \$5.00
Growler \$15 Sample \$1.75
A sessionable, malt forward Munich-Style Lager with a touch of spicy German Spalt hops for aroma and flavor and just enough bitterness in the finish to balance out the malt sweetness. Formulated by SAAZ home brewer Larry Reuter, who won Best of Show at the 2016 Son of Brewzilla competition. This beer will be entered in the GABF as a Pro-Am entry in October. ***Gold Medal and Best of Show 2017 Cleveland Oktoberfest.***



2. SPOOKY TOOTH IMPERIAL PUMPKIN ALE

9.0% ABV 22 IBU \$6.25 12oz Snifter
Growler TO GO \$23 Sample \$2.50
Rich amber color with aroma of sweet pumpkin pie and savory spices with hints of sweet malt. Rich and creamy with a chewy mouthfeel that you can sink your teeth into. Flavors of pumpkin up front then sweet malt, pie crust, spice, hints of brown sugar and a clean finish. We stopped just short of the whipped cream. But we like the way you think.



3. HEAD HUNTER IPA

7.5% ABV 87 IBU 16 oz Pint \$5.75
Growler TO GO \$17 Sample \$1.75
Uncivilized and aggressive this west coast styled IPA packs wicked hop flavors and aroma. Savage amounts of Simcoe, Columbus and Centennial hops define this brews signature pine and citrus notes. Try with our smoked wings in the Killer sauce and run the risk of a shrunken head! ***Silver Medal 2010 & Bronze Medal 2011 Great American Beer Festival. Silver Medal Winner 2012 & 2014 World Beer Cup. Brewing News' National IPA Competition 1st place 2010 & 2012.***



4. BUMBLEBERRY HONEY BLUEBERRY ALE

5.3% ABV 18 IBU .5L \$5.00

5. SUNSHINE DAYDREAM SESSION IPA

4.9% ABV 60 IBU \$5.75 16 oz Pint
Growler TOGO \$17 Sample \$1.75
As refreshing as wading in a cold stream in the morning sunshine or a walk among the tall trees, this beer has big hop aromas and flavors of citrus, peach, orange and tropical fruit with a nice light malt backbone. Like a sweet coming, never fade away dream... because it's deliciously real. This is a very drinkable session IPA. (Our fans call it an obsession IPA.) 6. MIDNIGHT MOONLIGHT BLACK IPA 7.8% ABV 79 IBU

16oz. Pint \$6.00 Growler TOGO \$19
Sample \$2.00 Dank resinous & citrusy hops flex their muscles while an aggressive, palate scraping bitterness rips through the mouth. Toasty caramel malt flavors and a dash of chocolate malt round this one out. ***Gold Medal Winner 2015 Great American Beer Festival; Bronze Award 2016 World Beer Cup.***



7. GOGGLE FOGGER HEFEWEIZEN

5.1% abv 18 Ibu .5L \$5.25 Growler TO GO \$15.00 Sample \$1.50
Traditional German style wheat beer served unfiltered. Hazy straw colored beer that hints at banana and clove complexity as all Hefe Weizens do. This thirst quencher drinks so easy it may fog your goggles. Pairs well with grilled smokehouse wings basted in our extra medium sauce. ***Gold Medal Winner 2010 Cleveland Oktoberfest. Bronze Medal Winner 2013 Cleveland Oktoberfest***



8. VIENNA LAGER

5.4% ABV 22 IBU .5L \$4.75
Growler TOGO \$14 Sample \$1.50
Originally brewed in 1841 by Dreher Brewery in Vienna, this German Style amber lager is malt forward with toasty notes. It is balanced by Noble hops and has a clean, crisp finish.



9. FEST BIER

5.3% ABV 25 IBU .5L \$4.75

Brewed especially for the Fest Bier season. Deep Gold in color from European Malts that lend a firm body with a toasted and bread-like mouthfeel. A true noble hop flavor and aroma come from German Tettnang and Hersbrucker hops. This beer represents the Bavarian way of celebrating. Prost!

10. TRAIL HEAD PALE ALE

11. ALPENGLLOW WEIZENBOCK

8.1% ABV 19 IBU .5L \$6.75

Ruddy orange in color, this unfiltered wheat beer enjoys a spicy aroma that hints at raisin, clove, banana and bubblegum. Full bodied yet very easy drinking with a toasted caramel malt finish.

12. PHANTOM PUMPKIN ALE

6.6% ABV 17 IBU 16oz Pint \$5.50

Like the Phantom, your beer will be gone quickly. Perfectly balanced spices, (cinnamon, ginger, nutmeg, allspice), make this pumpkin ale extremely drinkable. 13. IMPERIAL SCHWARZBIER

8.9% ABV 32 IBU 12oz Snifter \$5.75

BOTTLED BEER



Orval, Trappist Ale Florenville, Belgium
Belgian Golden Ale
6.2%ABV 11.2 oz. Bottle \$8.00

In contrast to all the others, the Orval Trappist brewery makes only one beer for the general public. It has an intensely aromatic and dry character. Between the first and second fermentations there is also an additional dry-hopping process. Through this the beer acquires its pronounced hoppy aroma and extra dry taste.

HARD CIDER: A GLUTEN FREE BEVERAGE

Shacksbury, Semi-Dry — Shoreham, VT 16oz. Pint \$6.00
Semi Dry Cider 6.5%ABV
Light and crisp with multiple varieties of apples grown in Vermont and England. Slow, partial native yeast fermentation aged over six months

Ciderboys, Strawberry Magic — Stevens Point, WI
Strawberry Cider 5%ABV 16oz Pint \$5.75

Come alive to crisp apple hard cider blended with the fresh taste of strawberries, soft and deep red, backed by mouth watering sweetness and a delicate hint of tartness. This is Magic Apple Hard Cider kicked up with a hint of Saturday night. We blend it a little differently around here. If you've never tried it, get ready for confetti.

INDIA PALE ALE (IPA)/ PALE ALE

IPAs are basically stronger, hoppier pale ales. Over the years, the style has evolved and even spawned a few subspecies or three.

Troeg's, Hop Knife — Hershey, PA 16oz Pint \$ 5.50
Wet Hopped Harvest Ale 6.2%ABV 87 IBU

Hop Knife Harvest Ale recognizes the time honored tradition of hand-harvesting hops at the peak of maturity. At the end of fermentation, the beer flows through our HopCyclone releasing a bounty of preserved citrus rind, crushed jungle and tropical aromas.

Boulder, Mojo IPA NITRO — Boulder, CO 16oz Pint \$ 5.75
Nitro IPA 7.2%ABV 70 IBU

Mojo India Pale Ale was inspired by the English who first shipped their ales to India and the Far East – but brewed with an attitude of the great American West. Pale in color but packed with flavor, Mojo reflects the perfect balance of hop bitterness and malt character. The unique Amarillo hop creates a big, grapefruit-like citrus flavor and aroma, making Mojo a very zesty IPA that's crisp and refreshing.

Columbus Brewing Company, Thunderlips—Columbus, OH
Experimental Pale Ale 5.3% ABV 16oz Pint \$5.50

It is a deep golden Pale Ale brewed with simpsons Malt Golden Promise Malt to create a backbone for thunderous additions of Mosaic & Equinox hops.

LAGER BEER

Broad family of beers with a wide range of strengths, colors and bitterness. Lagers are fermented with a different strain of yeast than ales, ferment at cooler temperatures and usually have a longer, colder maturation period (a.k.a. lagering). Lager is the German verb for "to store".

Lager Head's, Oktoberfest — Medina, OH .5L \$5.75
Oktoberfest/ Marzen 6.1% ABV 28 IBU

Lager Head's Oktoberfest is smooth and malty, brewed with German hops and yeast.

BELGIAN STYLE ALES

Remarkable and varied styles. A colorful, individualistic assortment of beer. Usually very complex, exotic and spicy.

Straffe Hendrik, Quadruple — Brugge, Belgium
Belgian Quadruple 11%ABV 12oz Snifter \$7.50

Straffe Hendrik Quadruple is a rich and intense dark Belgian ale. It is brewed with a subtle blend of specialty malts, which give the ale an extremely dark color and a chewy, malty complex character. The quadruple combines a clean dryness with a warm full bodied mouth feel and essences of fruit. Secondary fermentation in the bottle creates a living ale that can be aged and will have an evolution of taste profiles over time.

UNIQUE AMERICAN STYLE ALES

Thirsty Dog, Pumpkin Ale — Akron 16oz. Pint \$5.00
Pumpkin Wheat Beer 5%ABV
Brewed with summer's harvest of pumpkin, squash, honey, ginger, and love of great beers.

Saucy Brew Works, Punch Line — Cleveland, OH
Fruit Ale 5.7% ABV 12.4 IBU .4 Liter Goblet \$5.00

The worst jokes come from clowns. Clowns aren't funny. They even know they're not funny. So was born...the creepy clown. Our fruit beer is a tribute to fruit punch. Tons of fruit flavors come together in a haymaker that hits you right in the red rubber nose.

STOUTS , PORTERS & BROWN ALES

Dark brews with a roasted or toasted taste. Stouts are usually stronger & darker than porters. Nowadays though anything goes!

Baltic Milk Stout 8% ABV 30 IBU

Baltic Milk Stout named after the famous milk drinks in "A Clockwork Orange"

Portside, Bucheron Maple Smoked Imperial Brown Ale — Cleveland, OH 8.35%ABV 15 IBU 12oz. Snifter \$6.75
Imperial Brown ale using Maple smoked malt from Cleveland's Haus Malts and Geauga County Maple syrup.

Rochester Mills Woodward Bold Coffee Milkshake Stout, Rochester MI Coffee Stout 5.0% ABV 19IBU \$5.50 Pint
Rochester Mills creamy Milkshake stout infused with the dark bold flavors of Woodward Bold Coffee.

MEAD : A GLUTEN FREE BEVERAGE

Hop Nectar Mead, Crafted Artisan Meadery 12% ABV
Mogadore, OH \$7.50 per glass \$24.99 750ml bottle

Hop Nectar is a semi-sweet metheglin mead that is crafted with 100% raw Ohio wildflower honey, water and yeast. This traditional mead is then dry hopped with Cascade Hops prior to bottling for a perfectly balanced profile. Ohio wildflower honey provides the perfect platform for showcasing the king of American hops.

WHEAT BEER

Wheat beers are some of the most refreshing beers in the world. Made with a proportion of wheat malt in addition to malted barley. There are many styles and variations of wheat beers.

Ayinger, Brauweisse — Ayinger, Germany .5L \$6.00
German Hefeweizen 5.1%ABV

Delicious lemon and vanilla scented wheat beer with yeast. This is an aristocratic beer with a champagne sparkle and a beautifully sustained head. With the pale color of mountain honey and tart refreshing palate, it is a "brut" beer with the delicious, complex fruitiness of extra-dry champagne. Bottle conditioned and top fermented, it is a benchmark for this style of beer. The nose is fruity-spicy, herbaceous with lots of flowers, and fruit
