**6. JESTER ENGLISH IPA**

An English Style IPA with a medium malt body  
that is primarily hopped with the new English  
hop Jester, which was developed to emulate  
the fruit-centric US varieties and aptly named as a result of  
disbelief that these hops were actually English and the  
growers must have been joking. Notes of grapefruit, black  
currant and tropical fruit with herbal overtones.



**7. WORNERWEISS DAMPFBIER**

5.4% ABV 15 IBU .5l \$5.25 / Sample \$1.50 /

Growler TOGO 15.00 Named for a beautiful,  
magical creature that roamed the rural Bavari-  
an forests; this rare German style was brewed  
in the late 19th century with locally grown

hops and all barley malt (not wheat like a traditional Hefe-  
weizen) due to the high cost of wheat and its need to be  
used as a food source. A traditional German Weizen yeast  
is used for fermentation so the fruit and spice characteris-  
tics of a Hefeweizen are present. Think Goggle Fogger  
without the wheat...



**8. HOLLY JOLLY CHRISTMAS ALE**

7.5% ABV 28 IBU 16 OZ PINT \$6.00 SAMPLE

\$1.75/ Growler to Go \$19.00 Once upon a fro-  
zen evening way up north, a sweet local honey  
named Holly inspired our Jolly Fat Man (as only  
Holly can) to create this festive spiced holiday

### 12. BERLINER WEISSE

3.1%ABV 5 IBU .4L Goblet \$4.75

Light, refreshing Geman wheat ale with bright, crisp notes of lemon. Kettle soured with Lactobacillus bacteria to create thirst quenching tartness. Enjoy as-is or ask for some of Chef Derek's Blaubeere Sirup or Strawberry to flavor it!



### 13. JACK STRAW PILSNER

5.3% ABV 35 IBU .5L \$4.75  
Growler TO GO \$14/ Sample 1.50  
Bohemian and Bavarian Pilsners collide to create a crisp Pilsner brewed with Czech floor malted barley tenuously hopped with German Magnum, Tettnang and Saffir hops.



### 14. ALPHA CHINO DOUBLE IPA

9.2% ABV 94 IBU 12oz Snifter \$6.75/  
Growler TOGO \$24/ Sample \$2.50  
*Say hello to my little hops!* Alpha acids are the compounds found in the resin glands of hop flowers and are the source for bitterness for beer and Alpha Chino DIPA has no shortage of them. A mixture of Centennial, Simcoe, and Citra Hop pellets, whole leaf cones, and lupulin powder all contribute to this beer's assertive yet not overbearing bitterness and the citrus and pine flavor and aroma.



### 15. CHOCOLATE NIBULA STOUT

IMPERIAL CHOCOLATE STOUT  
9.6% ABV 35IBU \$6.50 12 oz snifter  
\$2.50 Sample \$23.00 Growler TOGO  
A cosmos of chocolate and cocoa flavors swirl in a glass. South American cocoa nibs and milk sugar give this brew its decadent flavor and aroma. Warming yet well rounded with just the right amount of rich, dark malt and roast. Boldly go where no man has gone before!



### 16. ONE DAY IN SANDUSKY SESSION IPA

5%ABV 42 IBU 16oz. Pint \$5.75/ Sample \$1.75 / Growler TO GO \$17.00  
Brewed for our friends at Small City Taphouse (Sandusky, OH) to celebrate their anniversary for the last 3 years. Session IPA with a light malt backbone brewed with Mosaic and Citra hops which provide a flavor and aroma of citrus and tropical fruit. An addition of fresh pureed lychee fruit boosts the tropical nose and coats your taste buds with a subtle and sweet finish



### 17. SUNSHINE DAYDREAM SESSION IPA

4.9% ABV 60 IBU \$5.75 16 oz Pint  
\$1.75 Sample \$17.00 Growler TOGO  
As refreshing as wading in a cold stream in the morning sunshine or a walk among the tall trees, this beer has big hop aromas and flavors of citrus, peach, orange and tropical fruit with a nice light malt backbone. ### 18. REAGAN'S COMET

7.5% abv 85 ibu 16oz Pint \$5.50

In honor of their child Reagan, Nathan and Lindsay White decided to start Reagan's Fund to help out families who encounter financial hardship due to costly medical bills. Brewed in partnership with our friends from Pies and Pints, this IPA packs a hop punch with Comet, Centennial, Citra, Chinook, Simcoe and Columbus. A perfect complement to a hot summer day with its tropical fruits and wild American flavor



### 19. BENJAMIN DANKLIN IPA

7.5% abv 80 ibu 16oz Pint \$5.75  
Growler TOGO \$17 Sample \$1.75  
The 2016 Craft Brewer's Conference in Philadelphia inspired brew we conjured up a recipe that brings American Enlightenment to the forefront. Benjamin Danklin is the Founding Father of Ales. With Centennial, Columbus, Citra, Chinook, & Simcoe it's loaded up like a lightning rod of lupulin. This beer is proof that God wants us to be hoppy!

## UNIQUE AMERICAN STYLE ALES

Cidergeist, Bubbles — Cincinnati, OH 16oz. Pint \$5.75  
Fruit Ale 6.2%ABV  
A cider/ale made with peach and cranberry juice, for additional pink hue, tartness and juicy fruitiness

## INDIA PALE ALE (IPA)/ PALE ALE

IPAs are basically stronger, hoppier pale ales. Over the years, the style has evolved and even spawned a few subspecies or three.

Platform, High Brow Barista — Cleveland, OH 16oz Pint \$ 5.75  
Pale Ale w/ Coffee Bean 6.4%ABV 46 IBU  
American Pale Ale brewed with Rye malt for a spicy character and dry finish. Moderately hopped and dry beaned with coffee for a unique nose.

Dogfish Head, Romantic Chemistry IPA— Milton, DE  
16oz Pint \$6.00 7.2%ABV 40 IBU

What you have here is a serious India Pale Ale shacking up and hunkering down with mango and apricots. At the same time! Romantic Chemistry is brewed with an intermingling of mangos, apricots and ginger, and then dry-hopped with three varieties of hops to deliver a tropical fruit aroma and a hop-forward finish.

Royal Docks, Tanglefoot — Canton, OH 16oz. Pint \$5.75  
American IPA 6.3%ABV 84 IBU  
A dry hopped full bodied IPA with a strong citrus presence

Uinta, Hop Nosh — Salt Lake City, UT 16oz. Pint \$5.75  
India Pale Ale 7.3%ABV 82IBU

Formerly known as Hop Notch. Wonderful complex flavors, like no other, simply a great tasting IPA. It's balanced, strong malt backbone, citrusy nose, with hints of pine and grass.

## HARD CIDER: A GLUTEN FREE BEVERAGE

Shacksbury, Arlo — Shoreham, VT 16oz. Pint \$6.00  
Dry Cider 6.2%ABV

Assertive and a little irreverent - just like its namesake, Shacksbury's resident bull. VErY dry, aromatic and earthy, with notes of grapefruit and apple. Aromatic, grapefruit, apple, and dry Apple varieties - A blend of eating apples from Sunrise Orchards in Vermont and European bittersweet apples Native yeast fermentation

## BELGIAN STYLE ALES

Remarkable and varied styles. A colorful, individualistic assortment of beer. Usually very complex, exotic and spicy.

Lagerheads, Plum Crazy — Medina, OH .4L Goblet \$6.25  
Belgian Dubbel w/ Plums 7.4%ABV  
A Belgian dubbel infused with sweet plums

Victory, Blackboard Series #6 — Downingtown, PA  
Peach Belgian Blonde w/ Coriander 7.5%ABV .4L Goblet \$5.75  
Bursting with fresh peach and spice aromas, this Belgian-style blonde ale features stone fruit notes with a touch of sweetness and a refreshingly dry finish.

## MEAD : A GLUTEN FREE BEVERAGE

Hop Nectar Mead, Crafted Artisan Meadery 12% ABV  
Mogadore, OH \$7.50 per glass \$24.99 750ml bottle  
Hop Nectar is a semi-sweet metheglin mead that is crafted with 100% raw Ohio wildflower honey, water and yeast. This traditional mead is then dry hopped with Cascade Hops prior to bottling for a perfectly balanced profile. Ohio wildflower honey provides the perfect platform for showcasing the king of American hops.

## WHEAT BEER

Wheat beers are some of the most refreshing beers in the world. Made with a proportion of wheat malt in addition to malted barley. There are many styles and variations of wheat beers.

Weihenstephan Hefeweizen — Freising, Germany .5L \$6.00  
Bavarian Hefeweizen 5.4%ABV 14 IBU  
A classic example of a Bavarian wheat beer from the oldest brewery in the world.

Arcadia, WhitSun — Battle Creek, MI .4L Goblet \$5.50  
Wheat Ale 6.8%ABV

Arcadia Whitsun is a modern interpretation of a mid-19th century English spring and summer festival ale. It is light golden in color with a rich, creamy head, full bodied and has a lightly toasted caramel flavor. The addition of Michigan star thistle honey contributes a uniquely smooth drinkability to this unfiltered wheat ale.

## STOUTS, PORTERS & BROWN ALES

Dark brews with a roasted or toasted taste. Stouts are usually stronger & darker than porters. Nowadays though anything goes!

Fullers London Porter, Chiswick — London, England  
Porter 16 oz Pint \$ 5.50 5.4%ABV 33 IBU  
A world class example of this historic beer style, smooth and creamy with delicious chocolate and coffee flavors derived from the roasted malts

Atwater Brewing, Decadent — Detroit, MI 16oz. Pint \$5.75  
Dark Chocolate Porter NITRO 5.5%ABV 11 IBU  
Holding true to the Northern English tradition, the Decadent Dark Chocolate Ale has at its foundation a nutty profile with a round mouthfeel. added is a Chocolate Extract consisting of three blended chocolates of varied depth. The result is a rich, but not overtly sweet, experience for both the beer and the chocolate enthusiast.

## CANS AND BOTTLES



Orval, Trappist Ale Florenville, Belgium  
Belgian Golden Ale

In contrast to all the others, the Orval Trappist brewery makes only one beer for the general public. It has an intensely aromatic and dry character. Between the first and second fermentations there is also an additional dry-hopping process. Through this the beer acquires its pronounced hoppy aroma and extra dry taste.
