5. CAVE MAN KELLER BIER

INDIA PALE ALE (IPA)/ PALE ALE

IPAs are basically stronger, hoppier pale ales. Over the years, the style has evolved and even spawned a few subspecies or three.

Boulder, Mojo IPA NITRO — Boulder, CO 16oz Pint \$ 5.75
Nitro IPA 7.2%ABV 70 IBU

Mojo India Pale Ale was inspired by the English who first shipped their ales to India and the Far East – but brewed with an attitude of the great American West. Pale in color but packed with flavor, Mojo reflects the perfect balance of hop bitterness and malt character. The unique Amarillo hop creates a big, grapefruit-like citrus flavor and aroma, making Mojo a very zesty IPA that's crisp and refreshing.

Mad Tree, PsychOPathy — Cincinnati, OH 16oz. Pint \$5.50
India Pale Ale 6.9%ABV

The subtle malt backbone combats the bitterness and intensity of floral, grassy, and citrus hop flavors. However, taste is perception.

STOUTS , PORTERS & BROWN ALES

Samuel Smith, Oatmeal Stout — Tadcaster, England
Oatmeal Stout 5%ABV 16oz. Pint \$5.50

Originally a drink for lactating mothers, oatmeal stout was described as nutritional on early labels. Oats are in the same family as barley, and a small addition yields great flavor. Popular in the late 1800's, the last oatmeal stout was brewed before the First World War until Samuel Smith reintroduced this style in 1980.

LAGER BEER

Broad family of beers with a wide range of strengths, colors and bitterness. Lagers are fermented with a different strain of yeast than ales, ferment at cooler temperatures and usually have a longer, colder maturation period (a.k.a. lagering). Lager is the German verb for "to store".

Paulaner, Oktoberfest Wiesn — Munich, Germany .5L \$5.25
Oktoberfest 6%ABV
Brewed once a year, and only available while supplies last, Oktoberfest Wiesn is the pinnacle of German brewing: deep golden color, full-bodied and wonderfully mellow, with a balanced harmonious taste and the pleasant fragrance of hops

Top fermented brews such as Kölsch and Alt which are still the specialties in and around Cologne and Düsseldorf.
