17. GENERAL SHERMAN RYE PALE ALE - Collaboration with Madtree Brewing

BARLEY WINE

Despite its name, a Barleywine (or Barley Wine) is very much a beer, albeit a very strong and often intense beer!

Thirsty Dog, Bernese — Akron, OH 12oz Snifter \$6.50
Barleywine 10.5%ABV 75 IBU

Like Mr. Buck, the Bernese Mountain Dog on the label, this is a BIG beer. A complex, dry-hopped, and unfiltered barley wine ale that will only get better with age. The malt aroma, possible only in a barley wine ale, together with deep malty flavors melds perfectly with the hops for a truly unforgettable experience.

INDIA PALE ALE (IPA)/ PALE ALE

IPAs are basically stronger, hoppier pale ales. Over the years, the style has evolved and even spawned a few subspecies or three.

Lagerheads, High 5 — Medina, OH 16oz. Pint \$5.50
American IPA 7.5%ABV 100IBU

American IPA with a citrus sweet hop profile and floral aroma

Platform, High Brow Barista — Cleveland, OH 16 oz Pint \$ 5.75
Pale Ale 6.4%ABV 46 IBU

American Pale Ale brewed with Rye malt for a spicy character and dry finish. Moderately hopped and dry beaned with coffee for a unique nose .

Platform, Elevated Hop Ramble—Cleveland, OH
New England Style IPA 7% ABV 16oz Pint \$5.50

Our next adventure into New England IPAs opaque, hazy & straw-colored. Huge grapefruit & lime citrus character carry through to the finish accompanied by stone fruit & subtle mint. Wheat & oats provide a soft mouthfeel which helps to round the bitterness.

21st Amendment, Blood Orange IPA — San Francisco, CA
IPA w/ Blood Oranges 7%ABV 16oz. Pint \$5.75

Our newest beer to be released in March. Brewed with real blood oranges with a base of Brew Free or Die IPA. We added some additional Citra hops to compliment the oranges.

WHEAT BEER

Wheat beers are some of the most refreshing beers in the world. Made with a proportion of wheat malt in addition to malted barley. There are many styles and variations of wheat beers.

Weihenstephan, Weizen — Freising, Germany .5L \$6.00
Bavarian Hefeweizen 5.4%ABV 14 IBU

A classic example of a Bavarian wheat beer from the oldest brewery in the world.

CANS AND BOTTLES



Orval, Trappist Ale Florenville, Belgium
Belgian Golden Ale
6.2%ABV 11.2 oz. Bottle \$6.99

In contrast to all the others, the Orval Trappist brewery makes only one beer for the general public. It has an intensely aromatic and dry character. Between the first and second fermentations there is also an additional dry-hopping process. Through this the beer acquires its pronounced hoppy aroma and extra dry taste.

Stockport, England
Extra Special Bitter (ESB) 4.7% ABV

LAGER BEER

Broad family of beers with a wide range of strengths, colors and bitterness. Lagers are fermented with a different strain of yeast than ales, ferment at cooler temperatures and usually have a longer, colder maturation period (a.k.a. lagering). Lager is the German verb for "to store".

Steigl, Grapefruit Radler — Salzburg, Austria
Radler 2.0%ABV .4l Club \$5.00

Steigl Radler is a combination of Steigl Goldbrau lager with fresh grapefruit juice. This results in a refreshing thirst quenching Radler that is low in Alcohol and perfect for a hot summer day.

Four String, Payback Pilsner — Columbus, OH .5L \$5.50
Pilsner 5.1%ABV

Our pilsner is an all-day drinker perfect for a rock festival weekend. This lager beer is brilliant with a gorgeous golden hue. We age it for nearly a month using a centuries old process to build a crisp, clean flavor that is perfectly balanced. The nose is bright with loads of herbal, cedar and floral hop aroma contributed by the finest hops the Bavarian Hallertauer region can yield.

STOUTS, PORTERS & BROWN ALES

Dark brews with a roasted or toasted taste. Stouts are usually stronger & darker than porters. Nowadays though anything goes!

Fullers London Porter, Chiswick — London, England
Porter 16 oz Pint \$ 5.50 5.4%ABV 33 IBU

A world class example of this historic beer style, smooth and creamy with delicious chocolate and coffee flavors derived from the roasted malts

Deschutes, Obsidian Stout — Bend, OR 16oz. Pint \$5.50
American Stout NITRO 55IBU 6.4%ABV

Deep, robust and richly rewarding, this is beer to linger over. Obsidian has distinct notes of espresso, chocolate, roasted malt and black barley, with just enough hop bite to cut the sweetness.

Hop Nectar Mead, Crafted Artisan Meadery 12% ABV

Hop Nectar is a semi-sweet metheglin mead that is crafted with 100% raw Ohio wildflower honey, water and yeast. This traditional mead is then dry hopped with Cascade Hops prior to bottling for a perfectly balanced profile. Ohio wildflower honey provides the perfect platform for showcasing the king of American hops.

HARD CIDER: A GLUTEN FREE BEVERAGE

Ciderboys, Strawberry Magic — Stevens Point, WI
Strawberry Cider 5%ABV 16oz Pint \$5.50

Come alive to crisp apple hard cider blended with the fresh taste of strawberries, soft and deep red, backed by mouth watering sweetness and a delicate hint of tartness. This is Magic Apple Hard Cider kicked up with a hint of Saturday night. We blend it a little differently around here. If you've never tried it, get ready for confetti.

GLUTEN FREE BEER

Sibling Revelry, Gluten Free Pale Ale—Westlake, OH
