1. RIVALRY PALE ALE

6.9% ABV 49 IBU 16oz. Pint \$5.75
 Growler TOGO \$17 Sample \$1.75
 Well balanced America Strong Pale Ale with just the right amount of bitterness and hop flavor to compliment a malt/biscuit body. Ohio grown malts, malted by Haus Malts of Cleveland, combined with Michigan grown Cascade and Chinook hops grown at Top Hop Farms in Goodrich, MI. Football season is just around the corner, it's never too soon to talk rivalries. O-H!



2. SPOOKY TOOTH IMPERIAL PUMPKIN ALE

9.0% ABV 22 IBU, \$6.25 12oz Snifter \$2.50 Sample/ \$23.00 Growler TO GO
 Rich amber color with aroma of sweet pumpkin pie and savory spices with hints of sweet malt. Rich and creamy with a chewy mouthfeel that you can sink your teeth into. Flavors of pumpkin up front then sweet malt, pie crust, spice, hints of brown sugar and a clean finish. We stopped just short of the whipped cream. But we like the way you think.

 Named for a beautiful, magical creature that roamed the rural Bavarian forests; this rare German style was brewed in the late 19th century with locally grown hops and all barley malt (not wheat like a traditional Hefeweizen) due to the high cost of wheat and its need to be used as a food source. A traditional German Weizen yeast is used for fermentation so the fruit and spice characteristics of a Hefeweizen are present. Think Goggle Fogger without the wheat....

Paulaner, Hefeweizen — Munich, Germany .5L \$5.50

Hefeweizen 5.5%

The no. 1 Hefe-Weißbier in Germany and one of the world's favourites. Naturally cloudy and shining silky gold in the glass under a really strong head of foam. At the first mouthful this Weißbier classic has a mild aroma of banana. Finer palates detect a trace of mango and pineapple and the balance between sweet and bitter.

INDIA PALE ALE (IPA)/ PALE ALE

IPAs are basically stronger, hoppier pale ales. Over the years, the style has evolved and even spawned a few subspecies or three.

Deschutes, Hopzeit — Bend, OR 16oz. Pint \$5.75

Autumn IPA 7%ABV 60IBU

If you're looking for a traditional Oktoberfest, head to Munich. This modern ale inspired by the time-honored flavors of a Märzenbier combines classic malts with the latest hop varieties from Germany to deliver an herbal and balanced Autumn IPA that's as at home in your backyard as the biergarten. Celebrate the season by sharing with friends, and skip the lederhosen- your friends will thank you.

Uinta, Hop Nosh — Salt Lake City, UT 16oz. Pint \$5.75

India Pale Ale 7.3%ABV 82IBU

Formerly known as Hop Notch. Wonderful complex flavors, like no other, simply a great tasting IPA. It's balanced, strong malt backbone, citrusy nose, with hints of pine and grass.

Elysian, Day Glow IPA — Seattle, WA 16oz Pint \$5.75

India Pale Ale 7.4% ABV

A touch of wheat hazes the malt bill, softening this bright & crisp IPA. Day glow is packed with juicy hops featuring pineapple & tropical fruit flavors & aromas.

LAGER BEER

Broad family of beers with a wide range of strengths, colors and bitterness. Lagers are fermented with a different strain of yeast than ales, ferment at cooler temperatures and usually have a longer, colder maturation period (a.k.a. lagering). Lager is the German verb for "to store".

Left Hand, Oktoberfest — Longmont, CO .5L \$5.50

Oktoberfest Lager 6.6%ABV 24IBU

This beer is available each autumn in celebration of the great Bavarian festival season. Brewed in late spring and cellared throughout the summer, our Oktoberfest is produced through traditional methods as it has been for centuries in Germany. This copper-hued lager owes its rich malt flavor to a generous combination of select Vienna and Munich malts.

The Brew Kettle, Oktofest — Strongsville, OH .5L \$5.75

Oktoberfest Lager 6.0%ABV 23 IBU

Amber hued with a rich malty character from a blend of German malts with just a touch of German Tettnang hops for added complexity.

Bell's, Quinannan Falls Special Lager— Kalamazoo, MI

Imperial Pale Lager 6.2%ABV 5L \$5.75

Born in a dream, Quinannan Falls Special Lager Beer refers to a mythical place in the boreal north. While the waterfall may exist solely in Larry Bell's imagination, the beer he remembered drinking there is now quite real. Quinannan Falls possesses the crisp, dry bitterness you'd expect from a German pilsner, but the use of highly aromatic hops from the Pacific Northwest in both the kettle & dry-hop evokes the fragrant pine forests that inspired this beer.

UNIQUE AMERICAN STYLE ALES

Southern Tier Warlock - Lakewood , NY

Imperial Pumpkin Stout 10%ABV 12oz \$6.50

Re-animate your senses with Warlock's huge roasted malt character, moderate carbonation and spicy pumpkin pie aroma. Particularly tasty with spicy BBQ, smoked or roasted foods.

Platform, 9021 Gose — Cleveland, OH .4L Goblet \$6.00

Watermelon Gose 4.2%ABV 41 IBU

Tart, salty and full of fresh watermelon puree this Gose is perfect for hot summer days.

STOUTS , PORTERS & BROWN ALES

Dark brews with a roasted or toasted taste. Stouts are usually stronger & darker than porters. Nowadays though anything goes!

Platform, Chocolate Nightmare — Cleveland, OH 16oz. Pint \$6.25

Chocolate Stout 5.3% 24IBU

With cacao nibs and hefty amounts of chocolate and crystal malt, its just like drinking liquid dark chocolate. Smooth and sweet with a balanced roast finish

Boulder, Shake Chocolate Porter — Boulder, CO 16oz. Pint \$5.50

NITRO 5.9% ABV 39 IBU

Our twist on the traditional robust American Porter, Shake Chocolate Porter is dark black in color with rich, sweet aromatics and flavors of dark chocolate, coffee and caramel. This unique brew blends five different grains, including Chocolate Wheat, that along with cacao nibs create a devilishly delicious chocolate finish with a velvety mouthfeel

Saucy Brew Works, Fauxbia—Cleveland, OH

White Stout 5.9% ABV 26 IBU 16oz Pint \$6.00

The only thing we have to fear is fear itself. Because it leads to all sorts of irrational conclusions, like dark beers are rich & heavy due to their color. Fauxbia proves that looks can be deceiving. This white stout is mashed at high temperatures with oats & wheat to create the body & mouthfeel of a true stout, but with a light golden color.

Black with ruby hues, Rolling Thunder Imperial Stout delivers a complex array of aromas and flavors that explode upon drinking, making this culmination of grain, oak, time and effort a revolutionary experience brought forth by the only brewery-distillery coooperation in the country

Working Class, Pipefitter's Porter — Cleveland, OH

Robust Porter 6.3%ABV 38 IBU 16oz. Pint \$5.75

A dark, full bodied porter with roasted malts and a smooth finish

BELGIAN STYLE ALES

Remarkable and varied styles. A colorful, individualistic assortment of beer. Usually very complex, exotic and spicy.

Victory, Golden Monkey — Donnington, PA 12oz. Snifter \$6.00

Belgian Tripel 9.5%ABV

Enchanting and enlightening, this golden, frothy ale boasts an intriguing herbal aroma, warming alcohol esters on the tongue and light, but firm body to finish. Exotic spices add subtle notes to both the aroma and flavor. Strong, sensual and satisfying.

Rochester Mills ,Tongue Tied Cherry Saison — Rochester, MI

Cherry Saison 6.2% ABV 24 IBU .4 Liter Goblet \$5.25

Inspired by Head Brewer, Bill Wamby's award winning saison (farmhouse ale) recipe, Tongue Tied Cherry Saison (6.2 percent alcohol-by-volume) is a traditional Belgian-style saison ale brewed with over a thousand pounds of both tart and sweet Michigan cherries. An unfiltered, slightly creamy ale with a pale reddish amber color and nice luscious white head. The distinctiveness of unmalted wheat is enhanced by the addition of lemon, orange peel and coriander, which provides herbal spiciness to this refreshing, pure Michigan summer ale. Slightly fruity and very refreshing, with a subtle tartness and tremendous drinkability.
